Early Intervention Services are critical to the healing of young children who have suffered a traumatic life event and are experiencing regressive behaviors including tantrums, separation anxiety, difficulty concentrating, poor impulse control, hyper-sensitivity, excessive crying, self-harm, aggression, failure to thrive and difficulty bonding with caregivers. At H.O.P.E. we are committed to providing a comprehensive approach to treatment for these children offering an Early Intervention Day Treatment Program, Parent Education, Psychosocial Rehabilitation (1:1 home/community based counseling), as well as Family and Individual Play Therapy.

- Early Intervention Specialists work together, with each family to promote healing, bonding, along with emotional, intellectual, and physical growth.
- Children will participate in a variety of activities that stimulate brain functioning and strengthen fine and gross motor skills, communication skills, social skills, and age appropriate developmental milestones.
- Children will learn to regulate their emotions including fear, anger, sadness, and anxiety.
- Parents are able to participate in parent/child bonding groups and parental education.
